



At 10:30, we will board our host vessel and cruise through Lock E7 with a demonstration by the crew. At Lock E6, we will stop for a barbeque lunch cooked onboard. Then the FUN begins with hands-on training while continuing through the “flight” of Locks E6-E2 and the Federal Lock 1 in Troy. This is where the tidal part of the Hudson River ends. Our cruise continues down the scenic Hudson River to our destination of Ravena-Coeymans Yacht Club. Ground transportation will be provided back to Schenectady.
