### **Water level at Varick Dam on Oswego River to be lowered on TUESDAY JULY 28<sup>th</sup>, WEDNESDAY JULY 29<sup>TH</sup> & THURSDAY JULY 30<sup>TH</sup>**

**Fulton, NY--** July 28, 2015 through 30 2015 – Brookfield Renewable Energy Group will be lowering the water level behind the Dam at **Varick** (between Locks 6 and 7) on the Oswego River approximately 3.0 feet below normal in order to facilitate replacement of flashboards on the dam and to facilitate a regularly scheduled inspection of the dam. The water level will be lowered starting early Tuesday July 28, 2015 in preparation for the work to be done on Tuesday July 28, 2015 through Thursday July 30, 2015. The water level will be returned to normal the afternoon of Thursday July 30, 2015. Dependent on the weather and/or flow conditions in the river, the flashboard repairs and dam inspection may be required to be cancelled and rescheduled for Wednesday July 29, 2015 through Friday July 31, 2015.
