NEW YORK STATE CANAL CORPORATION ANNOUNCES PARK AVENUE LIFT BRIDGE IN BROCKPORT TO CLOSE TO VEHICULAR AND PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC FOR REPAIRS

Work Includes Repairs to Bridge Lifting Mechanism, No Impact to Vessels Navigating on the Erie Canal

The New York State Canal Corporation today announced the Park Avenue Lift Bridge over the Erie Canal in the village of Brockport, Monroe County will close to vehicular and pedestrian traffic on Monday, July 25, 2022. The Canal Corporation will be repairing the lifting mechanism that raises the bridge for vessels navigating on the canal.

It is anticipated that this work will be completed in approximately three weeks and throughout the duration of the repair, the lift bridge will be in the raised position. Motorists and pedestrians should use the Main Street Lift Bridge throughout the duration of the repair. Boats traveling on the canal will not be impacted.

The Canal Corporation appreciates the public's patience while this work is completed.
